



have recognized nearly 200 outstanding individuals, organizations and building projects that went above and beyond to conserve Winnipeg's built heritage!





Advocacy in Action

In partnership with other **Provincial Heritage Agencies** we helped unite the heritage community at the inaugural virtual Manitoba Heritage Summit.






Through **collaborations** with local artists and cultural organizations we showcase Winnipeg's built heritage and aspire towards common goals.
