Heritage Winnipeg is a nonprofit charitable organization established in 1978. Our mission is to promote and encourage the conservation of historic/heritage structures.




WINNIPEG'S GINGERBREAD CITY HALL 1886 - 1962




WINNIPEG'S MODERNIST CITY HALL - OPENED 1962



The Millennium Centre



Constructed between 1910 and 1912 for the Bank of Commerce, the Millennium Centre is an opulent neoclassical building designed by premier Canadian architects Darling and Pearson. Located in the Exchange District National Historic Site, the building sat primarily vacant for many decades following the bank's departure in 1969.



The former Bank of Commerce and the Bank of Hamilton then became a rallying point for Winnipeg's heritage movement, and was one of the first buildings to receive the protection of municipal heritage designation in 1979. This same advocacy for Winnipeg's built heritage also resulted in the creation of Heritage Winnipeg. Today, Heritage Winnipeg manages the operations and ongoing conservation of the Millennium Centre.
