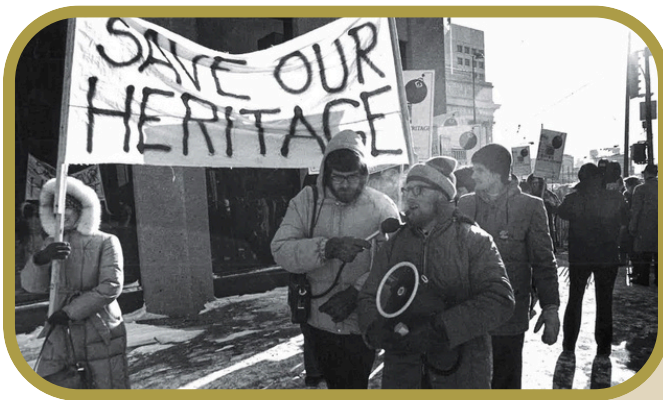
# All about HERITAGE WINNIPEG
